1. Written Test for the purpose of 20% internal assessment will also be conducted in all Theory Paper in respect for the student of B.A. Part-I, II & III classes during last two days of PCP. 20 questions of MCQ are required to be answered by candidates. Those candidates who do not appear in internal assessment test or take late admissions their 20% proportionate marks of the marks obtained in final examination shall be treated as score of internal assessment. The internal assessment once awarded will not be revised after words.

2. Since the PCPs are conducted for the benefit of the distance education students, and as mentioned in the Prospectus 50% attendance in the PCP is COMPLUSORY to become eligible appear in the University examinations exemption for attending PCP will not be allowed. No change of PCP centre/batch will be entertained in any case.

3. The candidates are also advised to Pay the balance fee/2<sup>nd</sup> Instalment fee upto 2.1.17 and submit the deficient documents, if any, immediately to confirm the eligibility for appearing in the University examination, failing which they will not be allowed to appear in the University examinations.

4. The candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their boarding and lodging during the course of the PCP. However, at Kurukshetra there are a number of 'Dharamshalas' and 'Yatri Niwas' of Haryana Tourism with mess Facilities on the main road near the University which can be contacted for the purpose.

**Note: - The annual examination of undergraduate courses will tentatively commence on 1st April 2017. If any candidate does not receive his/her Admit Card/Roll No. slip in time, he/she should contact the Directorate with three passport size photographs for issue of duplicate Roll No. Slip/Admit Card.**
