The second phase of Personal Contact Programme (PCP) of B.A. –I class will be held during the period from **05-03-2018** to **12-03-2018** for such student who could not attend the PCP held during last week of December, 2017 and period from **25-12-2017** to **31-12-2017**.

Registration of the students will be done at their respective PCP Centers from 9.00 A.M. onwards on **05-03-2018**.

1. Written test for the purpose of 20% Internal Assessment will also be conducted in all theory Papers in respect of the students of B.A. Part-II, class during last two days of PCP 20 question of MCQs are required to be answered by candidates. Those candidates who do not appear in internal assessment test or take late admission, their 20% proportionate marks of the marks obtained in final examination shall be treated as score of internal assessment.

2. Since the PCP's are conducted for the benefit of the DDE students and as mentioned in the Prospectus 50% attendance in the PCP are COMPULSORY to become eligible to appear in the University examinations, they are advised to attend the PCP classes regularly. No exemption from attending the PCP will be allowed in any case. No change of PCP center/batch will be entertained in any case.

3. The candidates are also advised to pay the balance fee/2<sup>nd</sup> Installment fee and submit the deficient documents, if any, immediately to confirm the eligibility for appearing in the University examinations failing which they will not be allowed to appear in the University examinations.

4. The candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their boarding and lodging during the course of PCP. However, at Kurukshetra there are a number of "Dharamshalas and Yatri Niwas" of Haryana Tourism with mess facilities on the main road near the University which can be contacted for the purpose.

Note: -1. The annual examinations of undergraduate courses will tentatively commence on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018. If any candidate does not receive his / her Admit Card/ Roll No. slip in time, he/ she should contact the Directorate with three passport size photographs for issue of duplicate Roll No. Slip/ Admit Card.
