**Note: (i) The Registration of students will be held at 9-00 A.M to 11.00 a.m. on the first day Of PCP.**  
**(ii) The timings of PCP 9.a.m to 1.00 p.m. on Sundays and Holidays.**

1. The candidates are directed to bring with them 30 Tracing Sheets (38x28 cm size) 20 graph papers, scale, set square, circle template, compass, protector, pencil, eraser, pilot pen black, stencils, sketch pen black and file cover.
2. Since the PCP's are conducted for the benefit of the DDE students and as mentioned in the Prospectus **50% attendance in the PCP are COMPULSORY to become** eligible to appear in the University examination, they are advised to attend the PCP classes regularly. No exemption from attending the PCP will be allowed in any case. **No change of PCP centre/batch will be entertained in any case.**
3. **The candidates are also advised to pay the balance fee/2<sup>nd</sup> Installment fee and submit the deficient documents,** if any, immediately to confirm the eligibility for appearing in the University examination failing which they will not be allowed to appear in the University examinations.
4. The students will have to make their own arrangements for their boarding and lodging during the course of PCP. However, at Kurukshetra there are a number of **“Dharamshalas and Yatri Niwas”** of Haryana Tourism with mess facilities on the main road near the University which can be contacted for the purpose.
5. **A written test will be held on account of 20% Internal Assessment in each theory paper during the last two days of PCP. Those candidates who do not appear in internal assessment test or take late admission their 20% proportionate marks of the marks obtained in final examination shall be treated as score of internal assessment.**

In view of this, the candidates are advised to attend the PCP. Though submission of written assignment is not compulsory, the students in their own interest are also advised to submit written assignments on topics concerning their courses for evaluation by the teacher.
