In accordance with the Scheme of Examination and Syllabus for the Master of Computer Applications (MCA) (CBCS) program, as outlined in the CBCS Curriculum (2020-21) of the Department of Computer Science & Applications, the guidelines pertaining to internships are stated as follows:

Internship Guidelines

Note 2: The Summer Training/Internship shall commence immediately after the completion of the 2nd Semester Examination and shall have a minimum duration of 45 days and a maximum duration of 60 days. Students must submit their Summer Training/Internship Report no later than 30th August. The evaluation of the report and Viva-Voce shall take place during the 3rd Semester. This evaluation will be conducted by a panel comprising one external examiner and one internal examiner.

As per the stipulated guidelines, the appointment of a supervisor from the department is not explicitly mandated. However, in the regular MCA program, it is a common practice to assign a supervisor from the department.

For the Open and Distance Learning (ODL) MCA program, it is recommended that the internship supervisor be appointed from the organization providing the internship, in alignment with the guidelines applicable to the online MCA program.
