Minutes of Staff Council

An urgent meeting of the staff council was held on 20/06/2020 at 11.30 AM through Video Conferencing. Following members attended the meeting:

The following items were discussed and resolved in the meeting:

First item of the agenda was to discuss the eligibility criteria for MCA 2 Year (four semester) Programme through Regular Mode:

As per AICTE Approval Process Handbook 2020-21, the AICTE has converted the MCA 3 Year Programme to MCA 2 Year programme and the eligibility for this programme as stated in the Approval Process Handbook is as under:

*"Passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree."*

OR

*"Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level (with additional bridge Courses as per the norms of the concerned University) obtained at least 50%*



marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the examination."

In the light of this change made by AICTE, the matter was discussed in the staff council held on 17.05.2020 and was unanimously resolved that MCA 3 Year Programme be converted to MCA 2 Year (i.e. Four Semester) Programme w.e.f. academic session 2020-21 for both C.B.CS (un-aided) and non-C.B.CS (affiliated institutes) with the following deviation criteria:

*"Passed BCA Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree Bachelor Degree with Computer Science as one of the major subjects with at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category)"*

OR

*"Passed B.Sc. B.Com. B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at the graduation level with at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) and additional bridge Courses i.e. one year Diploma after graduation such as PGDCA or equivalent."*

The deviation in eligibility criteria given by AICTE and resolved by staff council held on 17.05/2020 was discussed in the staff council held on 29.06.2020 and was justified and approved.

*The knowledge acquired by the student with Bachelor degree with computer science as one of the major subjects is equivalent to One Year Diploma after graduation such as PGDCA or equivalent. Thereby this criteria is equivalent to the AICTE criteria i.e. B.Sc. B.Com. B.A. with mathematics at 10+2 level or at graduation level with additional bridge course i.e. one year diploma after graduation such as PGDCA or equivalent.*

Further the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination given by AICTE and resolved by staff council held on 17/05/2020 was also deliberated upon and it was unanimously resolved as

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the percentage in the qualifying examination be same as the current ordinance of the MCA and is stated as under:

*"Should have passed qualifying examination with at least 50% marks (47.5% marks in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category)."*

In view of above resolutions the final eligibility criteria for admissions to MCA – 2 Year Course is stated as under:

*"Passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree/Bachelor Degree with Computer Science as one of the major subjects with at least 50% marks (47.5% marks in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category)"*

OR

*"Passed B.Sc./ B.Com./ B.A. with Mathematics at 10+2 Level or at Graduation Level with at least 50% marks (47.5% marks in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category) with additional bridge Courses i.e. one year Diploma after graduation such as PGDCA or equivalent"*

2. ✓ Second item was to discuss the eligibility criteria and duration of MCA Programme through Distance Mode:

The matter was discussed in the staff council meeting held on 20/06/2020 and resolved unanimously as under:

To keep MCA through distance mode at par with regular mode, the MCA 3 Year Programme through distance mode be discontinued and MCA 2 Year Programme through distance mode be started w.e.f. academic session 2020-21 with the following eligibility criteria:





*"Passed BCA/ Bachelor Degree in Computer Science Engineering or equivalent Degree/Bachelor Degree with Computer Science as one of the major subjects with at least 50% marks (47.5% marks in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category).*

*OR*

*Passed graduation with at least 50% marks (47.5% marks in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST category) with additional bridge Courses i.e. one year Diploma after graduation such as PGDCA or equivalent."*

3. Third item was to discuss syllabus and scheme of MCA 2Year, M.Tech. (CSE) and M.Sc. (Computer Science-Software) Programme

*The scheme and syllabus for various courses were discussed at length and it was unanimously resolved that syllabus and scheme would be finalized after taking feedback from the various stakeholders of the courses i.e. students, teachers, employers and alumni.*

Computer Science-Software (CBCS), and Mapping Matrix between COs, POs and PSOs for each programme were deliberated upon at length and it was unanimously resolved that the Mapping Matrix for each course of each programme along with Mapping Matrix for each programme be approved.*

Under any other item, the Request of the Director, Directorate of Distance Education for postponing the implementation of revised criteria/scheme of MCA programme having 2-Years duration instead of 3-Years, from the academic session 2020-21 to academic session 2021-22 w.r.t. letter no. DDE-178 dated 30/7/20 was considered.

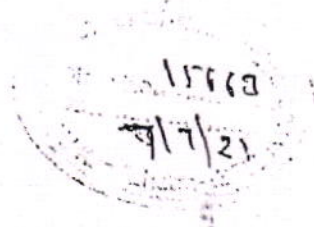
